Teaching English to Speakers of other Languages (ELTAB)

The LRN Level 3 in Teaching English to speakers of other languages is a qualification for learners who have limited or no experience of teaching English language.



Entry Requirements:

The Learners should have:

1. A good command of English in all four language skills (i.e. listening, speaking, reading, writing) equivalent to B1 on the CERF;
2. A good basic understanding of literacy, numeracy and ICT equivalent to level 2
3. Access to at least 3 hours of teaching practice in English language education.

Prior basic teaching experience is not a prerequisite as this is an initial teacher training qualification.

Assessment:

The assessment approach for this qualification consists of:

- Units 1 and 2 are assessed by an online written assessment. The content of the exam is set and marked by LRN;
- Unit 3 which is assessed by a 1 hour 40 minute end of unit (summative) assessment.

The LRN Level 3 certificate in teaching English to speakers of other languages (ELTAB) consists of the following three mandatory modules.

1 Language Awareness and Analysis in practical support of English Language Teaching (ELT)

2 Planning and Managing Teaching and Learning in English Language Teaching (ELT)

3 Applied teaching practice in the English Language Teaching (ELT) classroom

AIMS OF THE MODULES

Language Awareness and Analysis in practical support of ELT

The aim of the unit is to equip the learner with the language awareness and analytical skills to provide practical support in English Language Teaching (ELT).

- Understand the application of basic concepts and associated terminology in relation to phonology, discourse, syntax, lexis and language functions.
- Understand the application of basic concepts and associated terminology in relation to the four language skills for use in planning and managing the teaching and learning process.
- Understand the barriers to, and opportunities for, teaching and learning in English Language Teaching (ELT).

Planning and Managing Teaching and Learning in ELT

The aim of the unit is to provide the learner with knowledge, understanding and skills relating to selecting and using resources as well as managing teaching and learning in English Language Teaching (ELT).

- Know how to select and use appropriate resources in English Language Teaching (ELT);
- Know how to plan a lesson or sequence of lessons;
- Know how to manage the classroom and appropriate learning activities.

Applied teaching practice in the English Language Teaching (ELT) classroom

The aim of the unit is to assess the learner's ability to apply background knowledge and practical approaches to planning, teaching and learning in the English Language Teaching (ELT) classroom.

- Be able to plan and prepare a lesson or sequence of lessons;
- Be able to manage the teaching and learning process;
- Be able to act professionally towards learners and colleagues.
